Information about Restraining Orders and Court Dates during Court Closure

The Civil Courts are closed effective March 16, 2020 and will re-open April 6, 2020, unless that date is extended. You may still request a temporary restraining order during this time by completing the necessary paperwork and filing it at the Hall of Justice, 600 Administrative Drive, Department 107(J), Santa Rosa.

You may also still call the police or sheriff if you feel unsafe and request an Emergency Protective Order.

If you already filed a restraining order request, and the Court already gave you a hearing date, that date is no longer valid. The Court will notify you of your new court date via mail once the court reopens. During this time, your existing restraining order remains valid.
